## Info at a Glance:

- The Inaugural Class will begin Summer 2019.
- The academy will take place over eight months. Sessions will be held once a month on Thursdays, beginning June 27, 2019 and ending January 22, 2020.
- Academy sessions will run from 9:30 a.m.-2:30 p.m.
- Each class will consist of 25-30 individuals.
- Participation is open to individuals who live or work in Chesterfield County, or those who are members of organizations that serve Chesterfield County.
- The academy will meet at locations across Chesterfield County, and introduce participants to a variety of sites and opportunities.
- Academy presenters will be county leaders from different departments, who will offer their expertise about county programs and services, as well as community leaders who will connect participants to additional community resources.
- The academy is free to participants due to the sponsorship provided by the Asian & Latino Solidarity Alliance. (Participants will be required to deposit a refundable \$50 fee to cover meals and other expenses. This fee will be returned upon graduation.)

- Learn how to resolve issues.
- Obtain information and resources.
